



CHE Research Trust (CHERT)

Application for appointment as a Trustee

CHE (the Campaign for Homosexual Equality) has set up the **CHE Research Trust**, a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), whose aims include researching and documenting the history of CHE and of the wider struggle for LGBT+ rights. The CIO will have a Board of up to 11 Trustees who will be responsible for managing the CIO and its funds.

In order to register the CIO with the Charities Commission, we the CHE Transition Team has appointed 6 initial Trustees, but we are also seeking other people with wider experience, skills and contacts.

We are looking for people who have:

- the skills, knowledge and experience needed for effective decision-making
- a respect for the objects and intentions of the CIO
- a commitment to reasonable and prudent disbursement of funds
- a passion for the well-being and rights of LGBT+ people
- an interest and enthusiasm for LGBT+ history, in particular the history and influence of CHE and its contribution to changes in law and social attitudes
- a willingness to learn and to work to improve performance both as individual trustees and collectively as members of a decision-taking Board
- sufficient computer literacy to be able to manage written papers sent electronically and to participate in online meetings.

Our ideal Board of Trustees would:

- Represent the diversity of the LGBT+ community
- Include a variety of relevant skills and experience, for instance academic research, publishing, social media, charity administration, IT, and fundraising.
